### POLICY STATEMENT

Toms College of Engineering , Mattakara is dedicated to provide top-notch services to everyone, and this policy defines the process for current students to receive a concession. We will consider the concerns of the parents regarding our tuition fee concession. Therefore, we will permit our students to benefit from the tuition fee discount.

### PURPOSE

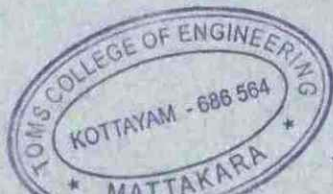
This policy's main goal is to guarantee that all students will commute safely. We do identify the students who are economically disadvantaged or meritorious students, and we provide them with a fee reduction for both their tuition and transportation costs.

### SCOPE

The policy only applies to students who are less fortunate in terms of economic situation and also for the students with outstanding grades in last qualifying examination. As a result, we shall be offering others our friendly helping hands.

### PROCEDURE

1. Students who applied for the RTF plan but did not receive full state government approval will receive a discount, according to management.
2. This applies to pupils who are economically disadvantaged and in case of students who have secured highest grades in the qualifying examination (Higher Secondary Examination/JEE, etc.) should submit the grade cards.
3. The parents' combined income should be under Rs. 1 lakh.
4. If the management is pleased with the supporting documentation, a concession may be made without the need for an interview.
5. If it will aid the particular family, Toms College of Engineering is willing to set up various payment options, such as semester-based, direct debt, etc.
